10	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code \S 5-61-403(3), concerning the definition of
11	"medical emergency" within the Arkansas Unborn Child Protection Act, is
12	amended to read as follows:

14	is necessary to preserve the life <u>or health</u> of a pregnant woman whose life <u>or</u>
15	<u>health</u> is endangered by a physical disorder, physical illness, or physical
