27	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 3-5-1704(a), concerning consumer
28	requirements under the Direct Shipment of Vinous Liquor Act, is amended to
29	read as follows:
30	(a) A consumer must:
31	(1) Be physically present at the winery to purchase the vinous
32	liquor to be shipped into or within the state; and
33	(2) Provide provide identification to the winery proving that he
34	or she is twenty-one (21) years of age or older.
