Arkansas Code § 20-77-2104, concerning Medicaid eligibility verification, is amended to add an additional subsection to read as follows: (g) To the extent allowable under state law and rules and federal law and regulations, in order to supplement data received from the Federal Data Services Hub of the Center for Medicare & Medicaid Services, the Department of Human Services shall directly obtain real-time employment and income data assets, including additional information assets such as address confirmation, contact information, death, and incarceration pointer data, from external data providers, including third-party vendors of commercial systems, to maximize the cost benefit of the Federal Data Services Hub of the Center for Medicare & Medicaid Services and to help the Department of Human Services make required eligibility determinations for Medicaid as required by federal law.
