

INTERIM STUDY PROPOSAL 2023-094

REQUESTING THE GAME AND FISH/STATE POLICE SUBCOMMITTEE OF THE ARKANSAS LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL TO STUDY THE FEASIBILITY OF CREATING A NEW UNIT OF THE DIVISION OF ARKANSAS STATE POLICE TO HAVE STATEWIDE JURISDICTION TO INVESTIGATE CRIME AND ENFORCE THE LAWS OF THE STATE, TO BE FUNDED BY THE ONLINE SALES TAX.

WHEREAS, crime in parts of the state has increased over recent years among both the adult and juvenile populations; and

WHEREAS, regular patrolling and policing of neighborhoods and communities by law enforcement has been shown to be an effective tool for reducing crime; and

WHEREAS, the increasing number of criminal reports, investigations, and unsolved crimes is a challenge for local law enforcement agencies; and

WHEREAS, the Division of Arkansas State Police can be an effective resource for increased patrolling and policing of communities, investigating crimes, and solving unsolved crimes; and

WHEREAS, online sales tax collected by the state may be a revenue stream that could fund an additional division of the Department of Public Safety or unit of the Division of Arkansas State Police to provide additional law enforcement services,

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT PROPOSED BY THE GAME AND FISH/STATE POLICE SUBCOMMITTEE OF THE ARKANSAS LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE NINETY-FOURTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

THAT the Arkansas Legislative Council refer to the Game and Fish/Arkansas State Police Subcommittee of the Arkansas Legislative Council a study to determine the feasibility of establishing an additional division of the Department of Public Safety or unit of Division of Arkansas State Police
