31	WHEREAS, the Arkansas Teacher Retirement System provides a valuable
32	service to public school district employees throughout the state; and

34	WHEREAS, despite the importance of a stable and productive retirement
35	system, it is likewise important to ensure that employer contribution rates
36	and other aspects of teacher retirement funding do not inhibit the ability of

public school districts to provide an adequate education to students throughout the state; and WHEREAS, one possible method of balancing these interests is empowering the General Assembly to review any future increases to the employer contribution rate or grants of additional authority to the Arkansas Teacher Retirement System, NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTY-SIXTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN: THAT the Joint Interim Committee on Public Retirement and Social Security Programs study the possibility of requiring further review by the General Assembly before any future increases to the teacher retirement contribution rate or grants of additional authority to the Arkansas Teacher Retirement System. BE IT FURTHER PROPOSED that the Joint Interim Committee on Public Retirement and Social Security Programs file a report detailing the results of the study with the House and Senate Interim Committees on Education on or before May 1, 2008.
