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32	WHEREAS, alternative learning environments serve public school students
33	who need a different learning environment based on social or behavioral
34	factors that make learning difficult in the traditional classroom environment
35	and who are therefore at risk of failing to achieve an appropriate level of
36	academic achievement or of dropping out of school; and



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1 2 WHEREAS, according to a 2006 study conducted by the Bureau of Legislative Research, alternative learning environments in Arkansas vary 3 4 widely in their methods of delivering instructional and behavioral assistance 5 to those students; and 6 7 WHEREAS, while a few programs in Arkansas have been successfully using 8 best practices as identified in research and literature, other programs are 9 less successful, or are used by schools as punitive measures for either the 10 students or the teachers assigned to those programs; and 11 12 WHEREAS, the Department of Education has few resources for monitoring 13 and assisting these alternative learning environments, 14 15 NOW THEREFORE, 16 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTY-SIXTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN: 17 18 19 THAT the House and Senate Interim Committees on Education conduct a study to determine what the best practices for alternative learning 20 21 environments are, how those best practices can be implemented statewide, and 22 what resources are needed to implement alternative learning environments that 23 provide the students in those programs with the opportunity for an adequate 24 education. 25 26 BE IT FURTHER PROPOSED that the House and Senate Interim Committees on 27 Education prepare a report detailing the results of the study on or before 28 May 1, 2008. 29 30 31 32 33 34 35 36

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
