For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO BE KNOWN AS THE "TIRE SAFETY ACT OF 2007"; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

AN ACT TO BE KNOWN AS THE "TIRE SAFETY ACT OF 2007".

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Tire Safety Act of 2007".

SECTION 2. Arkansas Code Title 27, Chapter 37, Subchapter 4 is amended to add an additional section to read as follows:

27-37-403. Tire safety.

(a) No person shall sell, offer for sale, or have in his or her possession with the intent to sell a tire for use on any automobile or Class One truck or van as described in § 27-14-601 if the tire has been marked "blem", "second", "imperfect", or any similar appropriate descriptive term.

(b) A violation of this section is a Class B misdemeanor.
