BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. The purpose of this act is to ensure the safety on roads and highways by addressing issues related to impaired drivers, specifically a driver who has been involved in an accident caused by a seizure that the driver experienced while driving.
