TO PROHIBIT AUTOMATED TELEPHONE
SOLICITATIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 4-99-405 is amended to read as follows:
4-99-405. Prohibitions.

It ~~shall be~~ is a violation of this subchapter for any person to make or
transmit a telephone solicitation:

(1) ~~Make or transmit a telephone solicitation to~~ To the
telephone number of any consumer included in the then-current database
maintained by the Attorney General pursuant to this subchapter;

(2) ~~Make or transmit a telephone solicitation without~~ Without
having first accessed, in the manner specified by the Attorney General, the
then-current database maintained by the Attorney General pursuant to this
subchapter; ~~or~~

(3) By utilizing a recording or an automated device that does
not permit interaction with a natural person; or

2 telephone solicitation violates the Federal Trade Commission "Do-Not-Call"
3 rule set out in 16 C.F.R. § 310.4, as in effect on March 1, 2003.
