Stricken language would be deleted from and underlined language would be added to the law as it existed prior to this session of the General Assembly.

29	fifteen (15) days on any of the days and times provided for in subsection (a)
30	of this section, if it so chooses.
31	(ii) If a county contains an incorporated town with
32	a population of more than three thousand (3,000) and the incorporated town is
33	more than twelve (12) miles from the office of the county clerk by way of
34	state or federal highway, the county board of election commissioners shall
35	place an early voting polling site in the incorporated town.
