## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO REGULATE LICENSED AND UNLICENSED  
RESIDENTIAL BUILDING CONTRACTORS; TO REQUIRE  
LICENSED AND UNLICENSED RESIDENTIAL CONTRACTORS  
TO POST BOND; TO IMPOSE FINES FOR VIOLATIONS OF  
BUILDING CODES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

TO REGULATE LICENSED AND UNLICENSED  
RESIDENTIAL BUILDING CONTRACTORS, TO  
REQUIRE LICENSED AND NONLICENSED  
RESIDENTIAL CONTRACTORS TO POST BOND,  
AND TO IMPOSE FINES FOR VIOLATING  
BUILDING CODES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. The purpose of this act is to:

(1) Regulate licensed and unlicensed residential building  
contractors;

(2) Require licensed and unlicensed residential building  
contractors to post bond; and

(3) Impose fines for violating building codes.
