

1 INTERIM STUDY PROPOSAL 2007-191
23 REQUESTING THE HOUSE AND SENATE INTERIM COMMITTEES ON EDUCATION
4 CONDUCT A STUDY OF THE SCHOOL CONSOLIDATIONS REQUIRED BY ACT 60
5 OF THE SECOND EXTRAORDINARY SESSION OF 2003.6
7 WHEREAS, Act 60 of the Second Extraordinary Session of 2003 was enacted
8 with the stated purpose of ensuring "the delivery of an equal opportunity for
9 an adequate education to the people of Arkansas in an efficient and effective
10 manner"; and11
12 WHEREAS, approximately sixty (60) school districts have been
13 consolidated in order to meet the requirements of Act 60; and14
15 WHEREAS, some of these consolidations have raised serious concerns
16 regarding both the fiscal and educational efficiency and effectiveness of the
17 resulting school district; and18
19 WHEREAS, there has been no systematic review of the impact of the
20 mandatory consolidations on the state's system of public education; and21
22 WHEREAS, such a review would provide critical information to parents,
23 school district patrons, educators, policymakers, and elected officials
24 regarding the state's public education system,25
26 NOW THEREFORE,27 BE IT PROPOSED BY THE HOUSE AND SENATE INTERIM COMMITTEES ON EDUCATION OF THE
28 EIGHTY-SIXTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:29
30 THAT the House and Senate Interim Committees on Education, with the
31 assistance of the Department of Education and the Division of Legislative
32 Audit, conduct a systematic and comprehensive study of the school
33 consolidations required by Act 60 of the Second Extraordinary Session of 2003
34 to determine if the intent of the legislation, ensuring the delivery of an
35 equal opportunity for an adequate education to the people of Arkansas in an
36 efficient and effective manner, is being fulfilled and to make

1 recommendations that would address any deficiencies discovered as the result
2 of the study.
