3 REQUESTING THE SENATE AND HOUSE INTERIM COMMITTEES ON PUBLIC
4 HEALTH, WELFARE AND LABOR TO STUDY THE DISTRIBUTION OF FUNDS
5 COLLECTED THROUGH BAIL BONDS AND THE COST AND PROCESSES FOR
6 LICENSURE OF BAIL BONDSEN.

8 WHEREAS, bail bonds play a prominent role in the criminal justice
9 system; and

10

11 WHEREAS, bail bond fees help to fund criminal justice programs; and

12

13 WHEREAS, bail bondsmen must be properly educated to ensure that the
14 bail system operates properly; and

15

16 WHEREAS, public safety and welfare require an effective and appropriate
17 mechanism for training and licensing bail bondsmen and for overseeing the
18 distribution of funds arising from bail bonds,

20 NOW THEREFORE,

21 BE IT PROPOSED BY THE SENATE AND HOUSE INTERIM COMMITTEES ON PUBLIC HEALTH,
22 WELFARE AND LABOR OF THE EIGHTY-SIXTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF
23 ARKANSAS:

25 That the Senate and House Interim Committees on Public Health, Welfare,
26 and Labor study the distribution of funds collected through bail bonds and
27 the cost and processes for licensure of bail bondsmen.
