3 REQUESTING THE SENATE AND HOUSE INTERIM COMMITTEES ON PUBLIC
4 HEALTH, WELFARE AND LABOR TO STUDY THE FUNDING FOR TREATMENT OF
5 SUBSTANCE ABUSE AND THE QUALIFICATIONS FOR SUBSTANCE ABUSE
6 COUNSELORS.

8 WHEREAS, substance abuse poses a serious, continuing threat to the
9 public health and safety; and

11 WHEREAS, treatment for the victims of substance abuse offers the
12 promise of returning those victims to productive lives; and

13

14 WHEREAS, substance abuse counselors must be effectively trained in the
15 use of the best available methods for returning substance abuse victims to
16 productivity; and

18 WHEREAS, funding for substance abuse treatment and the qualification
19 requirements for substance abuse counselors fall short of the needs of the
20 victims of substance abuse,

22 NOW THEREFORE,

23 BE IT PROPOSED BY THE SENATE AND HOUSE INTERIM COMMITTEES ON PUBLIC HEALTH,
24 WELFARE AND LABOR OF THE EIGHTY-SIXTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF
25 ARKANSAS:

27 That the Senate and House Interim Committees on Public Health, Welfare,
28 and Labor study the funding for treatment of substance abuse and the
29 qualifications for substance abuse counselors.
