

INTERIM STUDY PROPOSAL 2007-2011

REQUESTING THE HOUSE INTERIM COMMITTEE ON EDUCATION STUDY THE POSSIBILITY OF REQUIRING REGULAR INSPECTIONS OF THE PLUMBING, ELECTRICAL, AND AIR QUALITY SYSTEMS OF ALL PUBLIC SCHOOL FACILITIES.

WHEREAS, education is a primary obligation of the State of Arkansas;

and

WHEREAS, the condition of academic facilities greatly impacts the quality of education received by students; and

WHEREAS, recent legislative developments have highlighted the importance of academic facilities in the learning environment; and

WHEREAS, facilities issues such as plumbing, electrical, and air quality systems not only contribute to a comfortable learning environment but also directly affect student safety; and

WHEREAS, students throughout the state would be well-served by a study considering the possibility of inspections of these critical systems at least one (1) time per year,

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT PROPOSED BY THE ARKANSAS LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE EIGHTY-SIXTH
GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

THAT the House Interim Committee on Education study the possibility of requiring regular inspections of the plumbing, electrical, and air quality systems of all public school facilities.
