## For An Act To Be Entitled

12 AN ACT AUTHORIZING AUTOMATIC AWARD OF GENERAL  
13 EDUCATIONAL DEVELOPMENT DIPLOMAS TO ALL HONORABLY  
14 DISCHARGED UNITED STATES MILITARY MEMBERS WHO  
15 MEET ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS; AND FOR OTHER  
16 PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

19 AN ACT AUTHORIZING AUTOMATIC AWARD OF  
20 GENERAL EDUCATIONAL DEVELOPMENT DIPLOMAS  
21 TO ALL HONORABLY DISCHARGED UNITED  
22 STATES MILITARY MEMBERS WHO MEET  
23 ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS.

26 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

28 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 6, Chapter 16, Subchapter 1 is amended  
29 to add an additional section to read as follows:

31 6-16-140. General Educational Development diplomas for former military  
32 members.

33 (a) The Department of Workforce Education shall facilitate the  
34 automatic award of a General Educational Development diploma to any former  
35 member of the armed forces of the United States who meets the requirements of  
36 subsection (c) of this section.

1           (b) The Department of Workforce Education is encouraged to present the  
2 General Educational Development diplomas in conjunction with appropriate  
3 Veteran's Day programs.

4           (c) To be eligible for the automatic award of a General Educational  
5 Development diploma under this section, the former member of the armed forces  
6 of the United States shall:

7               (1) Have been honorably discharged from the armed forces of the  
8 United States;

9               (2) Be a resident of the State of Arkansas; and

10              (3) Have either:

11                 (A) Served a minimum of eighteen (18) consecutive months'  
12 active duty; or

13                 (B) Been rated by the United States Department of Veterans  
14 Affairs or its predecessor to have incurred a military service-connected  
15 disability.

16           (d)(1) The Department of Workforce Education shall adopt rules to  
17 implement this section.

18               (2) The Department of Workforce Education shall consult with the  
19 Department of Veterans' Affairs in developing rules to implement this  
20 section.
