

INTERIM STUDY PROPOSAL 2007-226

REQUESTING THE SENATE INTERIM COMMITTEE ON REVENUE AND TAXATION
REVIEW THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION'S PROCEDURE
FOR ALLOWING OR DISALLOWING A SALES TAX EXEMPTION ON FARM
EQUIPMENT AND MACHINERY UNDER A.C.A. § 26-52-403.

WHEREAS, A.C.A. § 26-52-403 allows a sales tax exemption on the purchase of farm equipment and machinery that is used for farming; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Finance and Administration is granted the authority to promulgate rules and prescribe forms for claiming the sales tax exemption provided in A.C.A. § 26-52-403; and

WHEREAS, confusion exists regarding the implementation and procedure under A.C.A. § 26-52-403 for allowing or disallowing a sales tax exemption on certain farm equipment and machinery,

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT PROPOSED BY THE SENATE INTERIM COMMITTEE ON REVENUE AND TAXATION OF THE EIGHTY-SEVENTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

THAT the Senate Interim Committee On Revenue and Taxation study the Department of Finance and Administration's rules and regulations regarding the sales tax exemption on farm equipment and machinery under A.C.A. § 26-52-403 and report its findings to the Senate Revenue and Tax Committee.

THAT the Senate Interim Committee On Revenue And Taxation study the Department of Finance and Administration's implementation and procedure for allowing or disallowing a sales tax exemption on farm equipment and machinery under A.C.A. § 26-52-403 and report its findings to the Senate Revenue and Tax Committee.
