COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTION COMMISSIONERS; AND FOR  
OTHER PURPOSES.

**Subtitle**

AN ACT CONCERNING TERM LIMITS OF MEMBERS  
OF THE COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTION  
COMMISSIONERS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 7-4-102(e), concerning term limits of  
members of the county board of election commissioners, is amended to read as  
follows:

(e)(1)(A) Members of the county board shall serve for a term of three  
(3) years.

~~(2)(B)(i)~~ As of July 31, 2007, members of the county board shall  
draw lots for terms so that one (1) member shall serve for a term of one (1)  
year, one (1) member shall serve for a term of two (2) years, and one (1)  
member shall serve for a term of three (3) years.

~~(3)(C)(ii)~~ Thereafter, all appointments shall be for terms of  
three (3) years, staggered so that one (1) term expires on January 15 of  
every year.

(2) No member of the county board of election commissioners

1 shall serve more than twelve (12) years.

3 SECTION 2. This section shall become effective on January 16, 2010.
