REQUESTING THE SENATE INTERIM COMMITTEE ON PUBLIC HEALTH, WELFARE AND LABOR AND THE HOUSE INTERIM COMMITTEE ON PUBLIC HEALTH, WELFARE AND LABOR TO STUDY HEALTH ISSUES THAT AFFECT MINORITY POPULATIONS.

BE IT PROPOSED BY THE SENATE INTERIM COMMITTEE ON PUBLIC HEALTH, WELFARE AND
LABOR OF THE EIGHTY-SIXTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

THAT the Senate Interim Committee On Public Health, Welfare And Labor and the House Interim Committee On Public Health, Welfare And Labor study disparities in access to high quality health care between minority and majority populations in Arkansas.

BE IT FURTHER PROPOSED, that the Senate Interim Committee On Public Health, Welfare And Labor study health issues that create special burdens for minority populations.

BE IT FURTHER PROPOSED, that the Senate Interim Committee On Public Health, Welfare And Labor study the administration of programs aimed at improving minority health in this state, programs including the Minority Health Commission and other state agencies with responsibilities for protecting the health of Arkansans.
