5 WELFARE AND LABOR TO STUDY HEALTH ISSUES THAT AFFECT MINORITY  
6 POPULATIONS.

8 BE IT PROPOSED BY THE SENATE INTERIM COMMITTEE ON PUBLIC HEALTH, WELFARE AND  
9 LABOR OF THE EIGHTY-SIXTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

11 THAT the Senate Interim Committee On Public Health, Welfare And Labor  
12 and the House Interim Committee On Public Health, Welfare And Labor study  
13 disparities in access to high quality health care between minority and  
14 majority populations in Arkansas.

16 BE IT FURTHER PROPOSED, that the Senate Interim Committee On Public  
17 Health, Welfare And Labor study health issues that create special burdens for  
18 minority populations.  
19

20 BE IT FURTHER PROPOSED, that the Senate Interim Committee On Public  
21 Health, Welfare And Labor study the administration of programs aimed at  
22 improving minority health in this state, programs including the Minority  
23 Health Commission and other state agencies with responsibilities for  
24 protecting the health of Arkansans.
