For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO PROTECT SCHOOL CHILDREN FROM INFECTIOUS DISEASE; TO REQUIRE IMMUNIZATIONS FOR DIPHTHERIA, TETANUS TOXOIDS, AND ACELLULAR PERTUSSIS IN THE SEVENTH GRADE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

AN ACT TO PROTECT SCHOOL CHILDREN FROM
INFECTIOUS DISEASE; TO REQUIRE
IMMUNIZATIONS FOR DIPHTHERIA, TETANUS
TOXOIDS, AND ACELLULAR PERTUSSIS IN THE
SEVENTH GRADE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-18-702(a1), concerning State Board of Health rules for school immunizations, is amended to read as follows:

29 (a)(1) Except as otherwise provided by law, no infant or child shall
30 be admitted to a public or private school or child care facility of this
31 state who has not been age-appropriately immunized from poliomyelitis,
32 diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis, red (rubeola) measles, rubella, and other
33 diseases as designated by the State Board of Health, as evidenced by a
34 certificate of a licensed physician or a public health department
35 acknowledging the immunization.

(2) The State Board of Health shall adopt rules to implement



1 this subsection (a), including without limitation provisions for a booster
2 immunization for children entering the seventh grade containing vaccines for:
3 (a) Diphtheria;
4 (b) Tetanus toxoids; and
5 (c) Acellular pertussis.
