24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 27, Chapter 22, Subchapter 1 is amended to add an additional section to read as follows:

28        27-22-109. Fee for allowing coverage to lapse.

(a) If the Office of Motor Vehicle of the Revenue Division of the

30 Department of Finance and Administration receives notice that the mandatory  
31 minimum motor vehicle insurance policy or alternate security required under  
32 the Motor Vehicle Safety Responsibility Act, § 27-19-101 et seq., and § 27-  
33 22-101 et seq. is not in effect on a motor vehicle as provided under § 27-2  
34 107, the office shall make a notation in the motor vehicle registration  
35 records of the vehicle identification number and the lapse in coverage.

(b) When an owner of a motor vehicle with a lapse in coverage



1 notation applies for the renewal of the registration of that motor vehicle,  
2 the owner shall remit a fee of one hundred dollars (\$100) in addition to all  
3 other licensing fees, registration fees, and taxes unless the owner provides:

4           (1) An affidavit that the vehicle has not been operated on a  
5 street, road, or highway in the state after the time the mandatory minimum  
6 motor vehicle insurance policy lapsed; or

7           (2) A statement from his or her insurance company or entity that  
8 provides alternate security stating that the insurance coverage did not lapse  
9 or the alternate security is still in effect and that the reporting was in  
10 error.
