22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

24 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 16, Chapter 13, Subchapter 2 is amended
25 to add an additional section to read as follows:

26 16-13-226. Law clerks.

(a)(1) Unless otherwise provided by law, each circuit judge of every judicial district may appoint one (1) law clerk who is a licensed attorney.

(2) A law clerk is to serve at the discretion of and under the direction of the circuit judge by whom he or she is appointed.

(3) The powers and duties of the law clerk are to:

32 (A) Administer oaths and affirmations;
33 (B) Take acknowledgments, affidavits, and depositions;
34 (C) Conduct research;
35 (D) Conduct pretrial hearings and prejudgment hearings



1 (E) Make recommendations for dispositions to the circuit
2 judge.

3 (4) A law clerk may be assigned additional duties at the
4 discretion of the circuit judge that are not inconsistent with the
5 Constitution and laws of the State of Arkansas.

6 (g)(1) The appointment of the a law clerk is subject to the approval
7 of the quorum courts of the counties of the judicial district in which the
8 law clerk is appointed.

9 (2)(A) The quorum courts of the counties of the judicial
10 district are to set by agreement the salaries of the law clerks and apportion
11 the payment of the salaries among the counties of the judicial district.

12 (B) A law clerk is entitled to the same benefits as other
13 regular county employees.
