22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

24 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-17-201(c) concerning personnel policies
25 is amended to read as follows:

(c) The personnel policies shall include, but are not limited to, the following terms and conditions of employment:

(1) Benefits;

29 (2) Compensation;

30 (3) Designation of workdays;

(4) Holidays and noninst

(5) The annual calendar;

33 (6) Methods of evaluation

34 (7) Extra duties;

35 (8) Leave;

36 (9) Grievances;



- (10) Dismissal or nonrenewal;
- (11) Reduction in force; and
- (12) Assignment of teacher aides; and

(13)(A) Random drug testing.

(B) The random drug testing policy shall include provisions detailing what action the school district will take if the random drug test for the employee returns a positive result.

SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 6-17-2301(c) concerning personnel policies is amended to read as follows:

(c) Personnel policies of concern to the classified personnel policies committee shall include, but are not limited to, the following terms and conditions of employment:

(1) Salary schedule, fringe benefits, and other compensation issues;

(2) Annual school calendar, including work days and holidays;

(3) Evaluation procedures;

(4) Leave;

(5) Grievance procedures;

(6) Termination, nonrenewal, or suspension;

(7) Reduction in force; and

(8) Assignments; and

(9)(A) Random drug testing.

(B) The random drug testing policy shall include provisions detailing what action the school district will take if the random drug test for the classified employee returns a positive result.
