12 AN ACT TO REGULATE THE ADMINISTRATION AND USE OF
13 STATE INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION FINANCIAL
14 ASSISTANCE TO STUDENTS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

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Subtitle

17 TO REGULATE THE ADMINISTRATION
18 AND USE OF STATE INSTITUTION OF HIGHER
19 EDUCATION FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO
20 STUDENTS.

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24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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26 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-82-105 is amended to read as follows:
27 6-82-105. Administration - Authority of Department of Higher Education.
28 (a) The Department of Higher Education shall administer all state
29 college institution of higher education financial assistance programs
30 provided by ~~legislation or by~~ law and in so doing shall have the following
31 authority and responsibility with respect to state college institution of
32 higher education financial assistance programs provided by ~~legislation or by~~
33 law to:

34 (1) Adopt such rules as the department shall deem consider
35 necessary or appropriate to carry out the purposes of this subchapter;
36 (2) Establish and consult, as necessary, an advisory committee



1 representing the private and public sectors of postsecondary education in
2 determining guidelines and regulations for administration of the student
3 financial aid programs, including, ~~but not limited to~~, without limitation
4 rules determining academic ability, financial need, and residency;

5 (3) Prepare application forms, parents' confidential financial
6 statement forms, or any other forms as necessary to properly administer and
7 carry out the purposes of this subchapter and to furnish the forms to persons
8 desiring to make application for state financial aid;

9 (4) Consider all applications for state scholarships;

10 (5) Determine a termination date for the acceptance of
11 applications;

12 (6) Require applicants to file additional information with the
13 department as necessary and appropriate to carry out the purposes of this
14 subchapter and to prevent fraud, misrepresentation, or misleading
15 representation by applicants;

16 (7) Determine the necessary procedures for the awarding of
17 grants ~~should if~~ the number of eligible applicants ~~exceed~~ exceeds funds
18 available;

19 (8) Disburse scholarship grants to qualified students through
20 eligible postsecondary institutions;

21 (9) Approve or determine the eligibility of any state-supported
22 institution of higher education to participate in or receive disbursements of
23 financial aid on behalf of students awarded any state financial assistance
24 provided by ~~legislation or by~~ law;

25 (10) Cooperate with and receive the cooperation of the approved
26 private and public institutions of postsecondary education in the state and
27 their governing bodies in the administration of ~~the scholarship program~~
28 programs;

29 (11) Employ or engage such professional, administrative,
30 clerical, and other employees as ~~may be~~ necessary to assist the department in
31 the performance of its duties and responsibilities; and

32 (12) Provide fair and equitable treatment to all approved
33 institutions and students.

34 (b) All financial assistance and scholarship moneys, including student
35 loans and grants, whether from public or private sources shall be:

36 (1) Distributed to the recipient as soon as possible; and

1 (2) Available for use at any local textbook retailer that collects
2 Arkansas sales tax if the financial assistance or scholarship moneys include
3 funds that may be used for textbooks.

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
