**For An Act To Be Entitled**

AN ACT TO PROHIBIT THE USE OF CERTAIN CUSTOMIZED  
TEXTBOOKS AND COURSE MATERIALS FOR UNDERGRADUATE  
COURSES AT STATE-SUPPORTED INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER  
EDUCATION; TO MINIMIZE THE COST OF TEXTBOOKS AND  
COURSE MATERIALS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

**Subtitle**

TO PROHIBIT THE USE OF CERTAIN  
CUSTOMIZED TEXTBOOKS AND COURSE  
MATERIALS FOR UNDERGRADUATE COURSES AT  
STATE-SUPPORTED INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER  
EDUCATION AND TO MINIMIZE THE COST OF  
TEXTBOOKS AND COURSE MATERIALS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 6, Chapter 60, Subchapter 6 is amended  
to add an additional section to read as follows:

6-60-606. Customized textbooks and course materials prohibited.

(a)(1) As used in this section, "customized textbook or course  
material" means an undergraduate textbook or course material that:

(A) Includes supplemental information, logos, design  
features, or any other information specific to the college, university,



1 technical institute, geographic area, or state;

2 (B) Contains information that produces no substantive  
3 change to the main text; and

4 (C) Is listed or treated by a state-supported institution  
5 of higher education as the textbook or course material required for a class  
6 to the exclusion of a textbook or course material containing the main or  
7 substantially similar text whether or not the supplemental information or  
8 alteration results in a new International Standard Book Number for the  
9 textbook or course material required for the class.

10 (2) "Customized textbook or course material" does not include a  
11 publication of selected segments or chapters of one (1) or more undergraduate  
12 textbooks or course materials if the wholesale cost of the publication is no  
13 more than fifty percent (50%) of the wholesale cost of the complete textbooks  
14 or course materials when purchased new.

15 (b) Except as provided in subsection (c) of this section, the board of  
16 trustees of a state-supported institution of higher education in this state  
17 shall prohibit the selection or use for instruction of a customized textbook  
18 or course material.

19 (c) A customized textbook or course material may be adopted after the  
20 effective date of this section if:

21 (1) The adoption is approved by the department chair and  
22 the dean or division head of the affected college; and

23 (2) The dean or division head of the affected college  
24 forwards to the board of trustees and the chief academic officer of the  
25 state-supported institution of higher education the following information:

26 (A) A list of each adoption;

27 (B) The names of the person or persons responsible  
28 for each adoption; and

29 (C) A written statement explaining the reason for  
30 adoption.
