15 EDUCATION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

18 TO PROMOTE PROMPT NOTICE OF TEXTBOOKS  
19 AND COURSE MATERIALS SELECTED FOR  
20 UNDERGRADUATE COURSES AT STATE-SUPPORTED  
21 INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION.

24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

26 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-60-601 is amended to read as follows:

27 6-60-601. Adoption of textbooks and course materials.

28 (a)(1) For each full semester and collectively for summer sessions, a  
29 state-supported institution of higher education in this state shall  
30 distribute a list of all textbooks and course materials required or assigned  
31 for an undergraduate course by:

32 (A) *Publication on its website; and*  
33 (B) *Posting at its bookstore.*

34 (2) The list shall be distributed no later than noon on:

35 (A) April 1 for the following fall semester;  
36 (B) November 1 for the following spring semester; and



1                             (C) April 1 for all following summer sessions.

2         (b) For each textbook or course material the list shall include:

3                             (1) A brief description of the textbook or course material;

4                             (2) The author or authors;

5                             (3) The title and edition; and

6                             (4) Any special instructions or circumstances for the purchase  
7 or use of the textbook or course material.

8         (c) A textbook or course material for an undergraduate course may be  
9 adopted or changed after the time specified in subsection (a) of this section  
10 for distributing the list if:

11                             (1) The adoption or change is approved in writing by the  
12 department chair and the dean or division head of the affected college; and

13                             (2) The dean or division head of the college forwards to the  
14 chief academic officer of the affected state-supported institution of higher  
15 education the following information in writing:

16                             (A) A list of each late adoption or change;

17                             (B) The names of the person or persons responsible for  
18 each late adoption or change; and

19                             (C) A written statement explaining why each adoption was  
20 late or changed; and

21                             (D) The information required by subsection (b) of this  
22 section for each late adoption or change.

23         (d)(1) Notification of a late adoption or change in a textbook or  
24 course material shall be emailed to each private local textbook vendor that  
25 requests notification of the late adoption or change within one (1) business  
26 day of receipt by the bookstore or department responsible for textbook  
27 adoption records at a state-supported institution of higher education  
28 concerning the change or late adoption required by subsection (c) of this  
29 section.

30         (2) The email shall contain the information concerning the  
31 change or late adoption required by subsection (b) of this section.
