

INTERIM STUDY PROPOSAL 2009-111

REQUESTING THE HOUSE COMMITTEE ON EDUCATION CONDUCT A STUDY OF
THE COST, EFFICIENCY, BENEFITS, AND POTENTIAL DRAWBACKS OF
CONSOLIDATING SCHOOL DISTRICTS INTO COUNTYWIDE SCHOOL DISTRICTS.

WHEREAS, there are a number of small school districts in the state; and

WHEREAS, small school districts can face financial difficulty due the student population and find it difficult to meet all academic requirements required by the Department of Education; and

WHEREAS, it would be beneficial for the state to examine the potential
benefits of countywide school districts,; and

WHEREAS, countywide school districts would reduce the number of school districts in the state and the administrative costs that stem from school district operation,

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT PROPOSED BY THE HOUSE COMMITTEE ON EDUCATION OF THE EIGHTY-SEVENTH
GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

THAT the House Committee On Education, with the assistance of the Department of Education, the Arkansas School Boards Association, and the Arkansas Association of Educational Administrators, conduct a study of the cost, efficiency, benefits, and potential drawbacks of consolidating school districts into countywide school districts.

BE IT FURTHER PROPOSED, that the House Committee On Education study include research on the following issues, at a minimum:

(a) The financial implications to the state and school districts of countywide school district consolidation;

(b) The criteria, including academic and fiscal, for school districts to consolidate into countywide school districts:

(c) Administrative and legal considerations involved in the consolidation of school districts into countywide school districts; and

1 (d) The academic progress of students who attended a school district
2 which have been consolidated or annexed into another school district.
