22 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 20-27-1903 is amended to read as follows:
23 20-27-1903. Tobacco use – Prohibitions.

~~Effective July 21, 2006 On and after the effective date of this act, smoking is prohibited in any motor vehicle in which a child who is less than six (6) years of age and who weighs less than sixty pounds (60 lbs.) is restrained in a child passenger safety seat properly secured to the motor vehicle in accordance with The Child Passenger Protection Act, § 27-34-101 et seq. eighteen (18) years of age is a passenger.~~
