1 INTERIM STUDY PROPOSAL 2009-177 2 REQUESTING THE ARKANSAS LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL TO REQUEST THE HOUSE 3 4 INTERIM COMMITTEE ON JUDICIARY STUDY THE USE OF GLOBAL 5 POSITIONING DEVICES FOR CERTAIN LAW ENFORCEMENT AND EDUCATIONAL 6 PURPOSES. 7 8 WHEREAS, Act 1447 of 2009 allows for the discretionary use of a global 9 positioning device by a Circuit Court in cases involving persons who 10 repeatedly violate orders of protection,; and 11 12 WHEREAS, global positioning technology has great potential to aid law enforcement agencies in tracking, locating, and monitoring criminal offenders 13 14 as well as for educational entities in reducing truancy; and 15 16 WHEREAS, the operational cost of using a global positioning device or 17 instituting a viable global positioning program is generally unknown due to 18 the current lack of use by law enforcement agencies or educational entities, 19 as well as due to the constant evolution of the available technology, 20 21 NOW THEREFORE, 22 BE IT PROPOSED BY THE ARKANSAS LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE EIGHTY-SEVENTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS: 23 24 25 THAT the Arkansas Legislative Council request the House Interim 26 Committee on Judiciary study the cost, application, and implementation 27 associated with the use of global positioning devices by the State in certain 28 law enforcement and educational capacities and report its findings to the 29 House Judiciary Committee. 30 31 THAT the House Interim Committee on Judiciary specifically address the 32 use of global positioning devices to combat repeat violations of orders of 33 protection, as well as truancy, and report its finding to the House Judiciary 34 Committee. 35 36
