

# INTERIM STUDY PROPOSAL 2009-203

REQUESTING THE SENATE COMMITTEE ON EDUCATION AND THE HOUSE COMMITTEE ON EDUCATION CONDUCT A STUDY OF THE PUBLIC MEETING FACILITIES PROVIDED FOR THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION MEETINGS.

WHEREAS, public education is of paramount importance to the State of Arkansas; and

WHEREAS, citizen involvement, participation, comment, and understanding of policies and issues presented before the State Board of Education is vital to the success of public education in Arkansas; and

WHEREAS, to encourage citizen involvement and participation in issues pertaining to public education, public meeting facilities for State Board of Education meetings must be able to accommodate such citizens; and

WHEREAS, there is a concern that the current public meeting facilities utilized for State Board of Education meetings are inadequate and unable to accommodate all individuals that desire to become involved in matters before the State Board of Education,

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT PROPOSED BY THE SENATE INTERIM COMMITTEE ON EDUCATION AND THE HOUSE  
INTERIM COMMITTEE ON EDUCATION OF THE EIGHTY-SEVENTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE  
STATE OF ARKANSAS:

THAT the Committees conduct a study of the public meeting facilities provided for the State Board of Education meetings.

BE IT FURTHER PROPOSED, that the Committees' study include, at a minimum:

- (a) A review of the current public meeting facilities; and
  - (b) A review of alternative public meeting facilities that may be available.
