2 AN ACT PROVIDING FOR REGISTRATION OF MINI-TRUCKS;
3 PROVIDING FOR OPERATION OF MINI-TRUCKS ON
4 ROADWAYS OF THIS STATE; EXCLUDING MINI-TRUCKS
5 FROM THE DEFINITION OF "ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLE"; AND
6 FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

28 SECTION 1. Title 27 is amended to add an additional chapter to read as
29 follows:

0 Chapter 25 – Mini-trucks

1 27-25-101. Definitions.

As used in this chapter:

(1) "Mini-truck" means a foreign-manufactured import or domestic-manufactured vehicle that:

(A) Is powered by an internal combustion engine with
a piston or rotor displacement of one thousand cubic centimeters (1,000 cc)

1 or less;

2 (B) Is sixty-seven inches (67") or less in width;

3 (C) Has an unladen dry weight of three thousand four

4 hundred pounds (3,400 lbs.) or less;

5 (D) Travels on four (4) or more tires;

6 (E) Has a top speed of approximately fifty-five miles

7 per hour (55 mph);

8 (F) Is equipped with a bed or compartment for

9 hauling; and

10 (G) Has an enclosed passenger cab; and

11 (2)(A) "Roadways of this state" means the part of the street,

12 road, or highway, including the improved road shoulder, that is open to

13 vehicular traffic and that is maintained by the State of Arkansas or by a

14 political subdivision of the state.

15 (B) "Roadways of this state" does not include any federal

16 highway.

18 27-25-102. Registration.

19 (a) A mini-truck shall be registered and titled in accordance with the

20 provisions of the Uniform Motor Vehicle Administration, Certificate of Title,

21 and Antitheft Act, § 27-14-101 et seq.

22 (b) The Director of the Department of Finance and Administration has

23 the authority to promulgate rules for the titling and registration of mini-

24 trucks.

26 27-25-103. Operation on roadways of this state.

27 (a) A mini-truck that has been titled and registered under the Uniform

28 Motor Vehicle Administration, Certificate of Title, and Antitheft Act, § 27-

29 14-101 et seq., may be operated on the roadways of this state.

30 (b) A mini-truck shall not be permitted to travel upon any highway in

31 this state that is a federal highway.

32 (c) An operator of a mini-truck shall comply with all traffic

33 regulations and rules of conduct for the operation of a motor vehicle on the

34 roadways of this state as provided by law.

36 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 27-21-102 is amended to read as follows:

1 27-21-102. Definitions.

2 As used in this chapter:

3 (1)(A) "All-terrain vehicle" means every three-wheeled, four-
4 wheeled, or six-wheeled vehicle seventy-five inches (75") or less in width,
5 equipped with low pressure tires designed primarily for off-road recreational
6 use and having an engine displacement of no more than one thousand cubic
7 centimeters (1,000 cc).

8 (B) The term "all-terrain vehicle" shall not include any
9 golf cart, riding lawnmower, or lawn or garden tractor.

10 (C) The term "all-terrain vehicle" shall not include a
11 mini-truck as defined at §27-25-101(1);

12 (2) "Low pressure tire" means a pneumatic tire six inches (6")
13 or more in width designed for use on a wheel with a rim diameter of twelve
14 inches (12") or less and utilizing an operating pressure of ten pounds per
15 square inch (10 psi) or less as recommended by the vehicle manufacturer; and

16 (3) "Public streets and highways" means the part of the street,
17 road, or highway, including the improved road shoulder, which is open to
18 vehicular traffic and which is maintained by the state or by a political
19 subdivision of the State of Arkansas, and includes any federal highways.
