12 AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND
13 ADMINISTRATION TO NOTIFY VEHICLE OWNERS THAT
14 MOTOR VEHICLES WILL NOT BE REGISTERED OR RENEWED
15 UNTIL ALL OUTSTANDING WARRANTS HAVE BEEN DISPOSED
16 OF IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE LAW; AND FOR OTHER
17 PURPOSES.

20 TO REQUIRE THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND
21 ADMINISTRATION TO NOTIFY VEHICLE OWNERS
22 THAT MOTOR VEHICLES WILL NOT BE
23 REGISTERED OR RENEWED UNTIL ALL
24 OUTSTANDING WARRANTS HAVE BEEN DISPOSED
25 OF IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE LAW.

27 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

30 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 27-14-1021(a), concerning annual
31 notification requirements for registering motor vehicles, is amended to read
32 as follows:

33 (a) ~~From and after January 1, 1998, the~~ The Director of the Department
34 of Finance and Administration shall cause to be mailed to each vehicle owner
35 in this state the following information:

36 (1) Notification of the requirement that each vehicle must be

1 assessed and personal property taxes must be paid annually;

2 (2) Notification of the procedure and time period for annual

3 assessment of personal property;

4 (3) Notification of the requirement that proof of liability

5 insurance is required and must be maintained at all times in the vehicle; and

6 (4) Notification of the penalties contained in Arkansas law for:

7 (A) Failure to assess the vehicle or pay personal property

8 taxes due;

9 (B) Failure to maintain liability insurance coverage on

10 the vehicle; and

11 (C) Operation of an unsafe vehicle; and

12 (5)(A) Notification that the vehicle owner has an outstanding

13 warrant issued by a court of this state for his or her arrest and that no

14 registration will be renewed until the outstanding warrant has been disposed

15 of in accordance with the law.

16 (B) The Director of the Department of Finance and

17 Administration and the Director of the Arkansas Crime Information Center are

18 authorized to promulgate rules and regulations to effectuate the purpose of

19 subdivision (a)(5)(A) of this section.

20 (b) The director Director of the Department of Finance and

21 Administration may comply with the requirements set forth in subsection (a)

22 of this section by including the information in the annual vehicle

23 registration renewal notice sent to each vehicle owner.

24 (c) The director Director of the Department of Finance and

25 Administration shall also cause to displayed, in conspicuous fashion, at each

26 revenue office in this state, the information set forth in subsection (a) of

27 this section.

28 (d) The director Director of the Department of Finance and

29 Administration shall also, ~~not later than January 1, 1998,~~ provide such

30 notice as is set forth in subsection (a) of this section, as well as the new

31 procedures, to all new and used vehicle dealers in this state.

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33 SECTION 2. Effective Date. Section 1 of this act is effective

34 beginning January 1, 2010.
