9 WHEREAS, the lack of parental involvement is one (1) of the biggest10 problems facing public schools; and

11 WHEREAS, parents of high-achieving students set higher standards for 12 their children's educational activities than parents of low-achieving 13 students; and

WHEREAS, research shows that the most consistent predictors of children's academic achievement and social adjustment are parent expectations of the child's academic attainment and satisfaction with their child's education at school; and

18 WHEREAS, research also shows that when parents are involved students 19 have higher grades, higher test scores, higher graduation rates, improved 20 school attendance, increased motivation, better self-esteem, lower rates of 21 suspension, less drug and alcohol abuse, and fewer instances of violent 22 behavior; and

WHEREAS, the earlier and the more that parents participate in a sustained way in their child's schooling in advocacy, decision-making oversight, and other roles, the more beneficial are the student achievement effects,
