16	TO CLARIFY THE UNIFORM SICK LEAVE LAW FOR
17	MUNICIPAL LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS.

20	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
21	
22	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 14-52-107 is amended to read as follows:
23	14-52-107. Uniform sick leave.
24	(a)(l) <u>(A)</u> From and after April 11, 1969, all law enforcement officers
25	<u>each law enforcement officer</u> , regardless of their titles <u>his or her title</u> ,
26	such as city marshal, employed by cities of the first <u>class</u> and <u>cities of the</u>
27	second class or incorporated towns shall accumulate sick leave <u>in accordance</u>
28	<u>with a municipal ordinance</u> at the rate of <u>not less than ten (10) working days</u>
29	<u>nor more than</u> twenty (20) working days per year <u>,</u> beginning one (1) year after
30	the date of employment.
31	(B) As used in this section, "working day" means the
32	period of time an officer is on duty within a twenty-four-hour period. If the
33	officer is on duty for twelve (12) hours or more in a twenty-four-hour
34	period, a working day shall be not less than twelve (12) hours nor more than
35	twenty-four (24) hours.

1	(C) The number of days of sick leave in effect for
2	officers employed by cities of the first class and cities of the second class
3	on January 1, 2011, shall remain in effect until changed by authority of a
4	municipal ordinance, and this section shall not be construed to require a
5	reduction in the level of sick leave below the rate of twenty (20) working
6	days per year or the rate in effect on January 1, 2011.
7	(2) <u>(A)</u> If unused, sick leave shall accumulate to a maximum of
8	sixty (60) days one thousand four hundred forty (1,440) hours unless the city
9	or town , by ordinance, authorizes the accumulation of a greater amount, in no
10	event to exceed a maximum accumulation of ninety (90) days, except <u>two</u>
11	thousand one hundred sixty (2,160) hours.
12	(B) Unused accumulated sick leave shall not be used for
13	the purpose of computing years of service for retirement purposes.
14	(b)(1) In cities having sick leave provisions through ordinance, the
15	total sick leave accumulated by the individual officer shall be credited to
16	him <u>or her</u> and new days accumulated under the provisions of this section
17	until the maximum prescribed in subsection (a) of this section is reached.
18	(2) If the governing body of the employing municipality
19	successfully reduces the accrual rate, no officer shall have any previously
20	earned sick leave reduced in value.
21	(2)<u>(3)(A)</u> Time off may be charged against accumulated sick leave
22	only for such <u>the</u> days that an officer is scheduled to work. No such sick
23	leave as provided in this section shall be charged against any officer during
24	any period of sickness, illness, or injury for any days which the officer is
25	not scheduled to work.
26	(B) If an officer is not scheduled to work, sick leave
27	shall not be charged against him or her during any period of sickness,
28	illness, or injury for those unscheduled work days under this chapter.
29	(c) If, at the end of his <u>or her</u> term of service, upon retirement or
30	death, whichever occurs first, any police officer has unused accumulated sick
31	leave, he <u>or she</u> shall be paid for this sick leave at the regular rate of pay
32	in effect at the time of retirement or death. Payment for unused sick leave
33	in the case of a police officer, upon retirement or death, shall not exceed
34	sixty (60) days salary unless the city, by ordinance, authorizes a greater
35	amount, but in no event to exceed ninety (90) days <u>of</u> salary.

1	(d)(1) Cities of the first class, cities of the second class, and
2	incorporated towns shall have the option of providing sick leave for officers
3	to accumulate at a rate of fifteen (15) twenty-four-hour working days per
4	year beginning with the date of employment and decreasing to twelve (12)
5	twenty-four-hour working days beginning four (4) years after employment.
6	(2) Unused sick leave shall accumulate to officers provided with
7	fifteen (15) twenty-four-hour working days per year sick leave and twelve
8	(12) twenty-four-hour working days per year sick leave to a maximum of one
9	hundred (100) twenty-four-hour working days.
