

1 INTERIM STUDY PROPOSAL 2011-185

3 REQUESTING THAT THE ARKANSAS LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL DIRECT THE JOINT
4 COMMITTEE ON PUBLIC RETIREMENT AND SOCIAL SECURITY PROGRAMS TO
5 STUDY THE CURRENT STATUS OF RETIREMENT SYSTEMS AND BENEFITS FOR
6 JUDGES.

8 WHEREAS, multiple public retirement systems provide benefits to judges
9 upon retirement; and

10
11 WHEREAS, it is the responsibility of the General Assembly to understand
12 how our limited public resources are utilized, including those resources
13 dedicated to public retirement systems; and

14
15 WHEREAS, the Joint Committee on Public Retirement and Social Security
16 Programs shall study:

17 (1) The different retirement systems that serve judges,
18 including the need for multiple systems; and

19 (2) Whether or not judges may benefit from multiple systems at
20 the same time, and if so under what terms and conditions.

22 NOW THEREFORE,

23 BE IT PROPOSED BY THE ARKANSAS LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE EIGHTY-EIGHTH
24 GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

26 THAT the Arkansas Legislative Council direct the Joint Committee on
27 Public Retirement and Social Security Programs to study the current status of
28 retirement systems and benefits for judges.
