## For An Act To Be Entitled

10 AN ACT TO REVISE THE MEMBERSHIP OF REGIONAL SOLID  
11 WASTE MANAGEMENT BOARDS; TO REQUIRE REGIONAL SOLID  
12 WASTE MANAGEMENT BOARDS TO INCLUDE A REPRESENTATIVE  
13 FROM THE PRIVATE SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT INDUSTRY; AND  
14 FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

17 TO REVISE THE MEMBERSHIP OF REGIONAL  
18 SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT BOARDS AND TO  
19 REQUIRE REGIONAL SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT  
20 BOARDS TO INCLUDE A REPRESENTATIVE FROM  
21 THE PRIVATE SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT  
22 INDUSTRY.

26 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
27

28 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 8-6-703(b), concerning the membership of a  
29 regional solid waste management board, is amended to read as follows:

30 (b)(1) Each regional solid waste management board shall be composed of  
31 representatives of:

- 32 (A) The counties within the district;
- 33 (B) All cities of the first class within the district;
- 34 (C) All cities with a population ~~over~~ of more than two  
35 thousand (2,000) within the district according to the most recent federal  
36 decennial census;

1 (D) The largest city of each county within the district;

2 ~~and~~

3 (E) Any city within the district that holds a position on  
4 any regional solid waste management board on or after January 1, 2010~~+~~; and

5 (F)(i) The private solid waste management industry.

6 (ii) The board shall select one (1) owner or  
7 operator of a private sector solid waste management facility located in the  
8 district to serve as the representative of the private solid waste management  
9 industry.

10 (2) The county judge of each county within the district and the mayor  
11 of each city entitled to a representative in the district shall serve on the  
12 board, unless the county judge or mayor elects instead to appoint a member as  
13 follows:

14 (A) The county judge, with confirmation by the quorum  
15 court of each county within the district, shall appoint one (1) member to the  
16 board; and

17 (B) The mayor, with confirmation by the governing body of  
18 each city entitled to a representative in the district, shall appoint one (1)  
19 member.
