1 INTERIM STUDY PROPOSAL 2011-203 2 REQUESTING THAT THE ARKANSAS LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL REFER TO THE 3 HOUSE COMMITTEE ON AGING, CHILDREN AND YOUTH, LEGISLATIVE & 4 5 MILITARY AFFAIRS A STUDY OF THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE ARKANSAS 6 DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS, THE STATE'S VETERANS HOMES' 7 PROCEDURES, SAFETY, FUNDING, AND THE STANDARDS OF CARE, AND 8 ALTERNATIVES FOR PROVIDING PROPER CARE AND TREATMENT FOR THE 9 STATE'S MILITARY VETERANS. 10 11 WHEREAS, the state's veterans have proudly served our country and 12 earned the benefits provided by the federal government and the State of 13 Arkansas; and 14 15 WHEREAS, the state has recently learned and recent news headlines 16 illustrate that: 17 (1) The Little Rock Veterans Home collected unauthorized moneys 18 from our state's war-wounded and disabled veterans who reside at the Little 19 Rock Veterans Home; 20 That the Little Rock Veterans Home may have felt compelled (2) 21 to improperly collect these moneys due to inadequate funding to maintain the 22 home; and 23 (3) The Little Rock Veterans Home improperly collected more than 24 \$580,000.00 in maintenance fees and is unable to repay the wrongfully 25 charged veterans who reside at the home; and 26 27 WHEREAS, the state has a veteran population of over 257,625 and the 28 proper administration of benefits, funding, care, and facilities for the 29 state's veterans is important to the state; and 30 31 WHEREAS, all feasible solutions and alternatives should be considered 32 to cure any deficiencies in the state's veterans homes or administration of 33 benefits, 34 35 NOW THEREFORE, 36 BE IT PROPOSED BY THE ARKANSAS LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE EIGHTY-EIGHTH
