(a) The general election laws shall apply to school elections insofar 3 4 as they are not in conflict with the school election laws. 5 (b) The county board of election commissioners may include the annual 6 school election on a separate ballot if the board determines that a separate 7 ballot is necessary to avoid voter confusion. 8 9 SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 6-14-102(a)(1), concerning the annual school election date, is amended to read as follows: 10 (a)(1) The annual school election shall be held in each school 11 12 district of the state on the third Tuesday in September Tuesday next after the first Monday in November of each year. 13 14 15 SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 6-14-118 is amended to read as follows: 16 6-14-118.
