1 INTERIM STUDY PROPOSAL 2011-223 2 REQUESTING THAT THE INTERIM SENATE COMMITTEE ON STATE AGENCIES 3 AND GOVERNMENTAL AFFAIRS STUDY THE LAWS AND PROCEDURES FOR 4 PROPOSING A LEGISLATIVE MEASURE BY INITIATIVE PETITION TO ENSURE 5 6 THAT THE PROCESS FUNCTIONS FAIRLY, PROPERLY, AND FREE FROM FRAUD 7 OR TRREGULARITIES. 8 9 WHEREAS, under Article 5, § 1, of the Arkansas Constitution, the power 10 to propose legislative measures, laws, and amendments to the Constitution, 11 and to enact or reject the same at the polls independent of the General 12 Assembly, is reserved to the people of the State of Arkansas; and 13 14 WHEREAS, the process and procedures for exercising the people's right 15 to initiate legislative measures, laws, and amendments to the Constitution 16 should function fairly, properly, and free from fraud or irregularities; and 17 18 WHEREAS, the Constitution and laws of this State should be examined and 19 recommendations made where appropriate to ensure that all aspects of the 20 initiative process function properly, and that appropriate penalties are in 21 place to help ensure the proper functioning of the process, 22 23 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT PROPOSED BY THE INTERIM SENATE COMMITTEE ON STATE AGENCIES AND 24 25 GOVERNMENTAL AFFAIRS OF THE EIGHTY-EIGHTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF 26 ARKANSAS: 27 28 THAT the Interim Senate Committee on State Agencies and Governmental 29 Affairs study the laws and procedures for proposing a legislative measure by 30 initiative by petition to ensure that the process functions fairly and 31 properly, and free from fraud or irregularities. 32 33 34 35 36
