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28	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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30	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 27-16-706 is amended to read as follows:

32	The driver's license test shall include written questions concerning:
33	(1) The effects of the consumption of alcoholic beverage
34	products and the use of illegal drugs, prescription drugs, and
35	nonprescription drugs on the ability of a person to operate a motor vehicle;

2	violations of the state's laws prohibiting the operation of a motor vehicle
3	while under the influence of alcohol or drugs;
4	(3) Accessible parking for a person with a disability; and
5	(4) Penalties for the unauthorized use of parking designated for
6	the exclusive use of a person with a disability $ au_{;}$ and
7	(5) The effects and hazards of distracted driving and the
8	penalties for violations of state distracted driving laws.
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10	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 27-16-804(b)(2)(B)(iii), concerning the use
11	of a cellular telephone device by a driver under eighteen (18) years of age,
12	is amended to read as follows:

15	device while operating a motor vehicle except for an emergency purpose <u>as</u>
