           This subchapter shall be known and may be cited as the "Arkansas Public
     Notice Act of 2013".

1	25-1-502. Legislative intent.
2	The General Assembly having determined that government entities spend a
3	substantial amount of money on advertising mandated by law and that the
4	Internet is a more accessible and affordable means of disseminating
5	information to the public than current methods, it is the purpose of this
6	subchapter to save public funds by allowing government entities to publish
7	public notice in the manner that is the least expensive to that government
8	entity and the most accessible to the public.
9	
10	25-1-503. Definitions.
11	As used in this subchapter:
12	(1) "Government entity" means an agency, department, authority,
13	board, commission, bureau, council, office, or other agency of state, county,
14	or municipal government; and
15	(2) "Website" means a site on the Internet:
16	(A) Identifiable by a specific uniform resource locator;
17	(B) Accessible to the public at no cost; and
18	(C) Requiring no information of the user.
19	
20	25-1-504. Creation of a public notice calendar website.
21	(a) The Secretary of State shall:
22	(1) Establish standards and criteria for government entities and
23	private entities required by law to publish public notice to report dates,
24	times, locations, descriptions, and other details of public notice required
25	by law;
26	(2) Develop and maintain a database of the dates, times,
27	locations, descriptions, and other details of public notice required by law
28	to be published;
29	(3) Develop a website presenting a public notice calendar that
30	shall:
31	(A) Contain a section in calendar format;
32	(B) Contain a section for notices that are not date
33	specific, including without limitation notice of an order, finding,
34	resolution, proclamation, or adoption;

1	(C) Report information required by law for publication as
2	requested by government entities following the guidelines under subdivision
3	(a)(1) of this section; and
4	(D) Allow searches by date, government entity, county, and
5	any other method that assists the public in obtaining public notice
6	information; and
7	(4) Update the website on a regular basis to present current
8	dates, locations, and information to the public.
9	(b)(1) The Secretary of State may set a fee for publication on the
10	website.
11	(2) If setting a fee for publication on the website, the
12	Secretary of State shall:
13	(A) Develop and promulgate rules setting fees for
14	publication on the website; and
15	(B) Consider the:
16	(i) Cost to government entities for publication by
17	newspaper; and
18	(ii) Savings to government entities for publication
19	on the website.
20	(c) Revenue generated by collection of fees shall be deposited into a
21	cash fund to be used by the Secretary of State as provided under § 19-6-103.

23	25-1-505. Sufficient public notice for government entities.
24	(a) A government entity required to publish public notice under law
25	may publish public notice in:
26	(1) A legal newspaper or newspaper of general circulation under
27	<u>§ 16-3-101 et seq.; or</u>
28	(2) The public notice calendar website under this subchapter.
29	(b)(1) If notice is published for a period of time on the website, the
30	notice shall be published for the total number of days provided under law.
31	(2) If notice is published for a period of time by a newspaper,
32	the notice shall be published by one (1) insertion or advertisement for each
33	week of the time period specified by law.
34	(c)(l) Unless otherwise provided by law, notice by website under this
35	subchapter shall be published for at least two (2) weeks before the event of
36	which the government entity is notifying the public.

1	(2) Unless otherwise provided by law, notice by newspaper under
2	this subchapter shall be published by one (1) insertion or advertisement each
3	week for two (2) weeks before the event of which the government entity is
4	notifying the public.
5	(d) If notice is provided for under the Arkansas Constitution, then
6	notice shall be published under the constitutional provision.
