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30	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE EIGHTY-NINTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE
31	STATE OF ARKANSAS AND BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, A MAJORITY OF ALL
32	MEMBERS ELECTED TO EACH HOUSE AGREEING THERETO:
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35	THAT the following is proposed as an amendment to the Constitution of
36	the State of Arkansas, and upon being submitted to the electors of the state

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1	for approval or rejection at the next general election for Representatives
2	and Senators, if a majority of the electors voting thereon at the election
3	adopt the amendment, the amendment shall become a part of the Constitution of
4	the State of Arkansas, to wit:
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6	SECTION 1. (a) The General Assembly may enact a law to levy a tax or
7	to increase the rate of any tax only upon the affirmative vote of three-
8	fourths (3/4) of the members elected to each house of the General Assembly.
9	(b) The General Assembly shall not enact a law to decrease the rate of
10	any tax or to provide a tax exemption, credit, exclusion, or deduction except
11	upon the affirmative vote of a majority of the members elected to each house
12	of the General Assembly.
13	(c) The General Assembly shall not enact a law to remove a tax
14	exemption, credit, exclusion, or deduction except upon the affirmative vote
15	of a majority of the members elected to each house of the General Assembly.
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17	SECTION 2. This amendment shall be known as the "Taxpayers' Protection
18	Amendment".
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20	SECTION 3. This amendment shall become effective January 1, 2015.
