1 INTERIM STUDY PROPOSAL 2015-135 2 REQUESTING THAT THE ARKANSAS LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL REFER TO THE 3 4 HOUSE COMMITTEE ON JUDICIARY A REQUEST TO STUDY THE CIRCUMSTANCES 5 CONCERNING AND PROCEDURES FOR FINGERPRINTING AND PHOTOGRAPHING A 6 JUVENILE FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT PURPOSES, AS WELL AS THE 7 REQUIREMENTS AND PROCESS FOR SEALING OR EXPUNGING THOSE RECORDS. 8 9 WHEREAS, a juvenile's interaction with a law enforcement agency and the 10 criminal justice system should be managed with the utmost care; and 11 12 WHEREAS, the arrest of a juvenile for a criminal offense has repercussions that can last well into adulthood; and 13 14 WHEREAS, Acts 2015, No. 1016, addresses the circumstances concerning 15 16 and the procedures for fingerprinting and photographing a juvenile, requiring 17 that, before the juvenile's fingerprints are taken by the arresting law 18 enforcement agency, the juvenile is either arrested for an offense that if 19 committed by an adult would constitute a Class Y, Class A, or Class B felony or, in the case of an allegation of delinquency, in custody for an offense 20 21 that if committed by an adult would constitute a Class Y, Class A, or Class B 22 felony; and 23 24 WHEREAS, the sealing or expungement of a juvenile's fingerprints and 25 photograph from the criminal justice system should be an option under certain 26 circumstances; and 27 28 WHEREAS, further study is needed of the circumstances concerning and 29 the procedures for fingerprinting and photographing a juvenile by a law enforcement agency, as well as the requirements and process of sealing or 30 31 expunging those records, 32 33 NOW THEREFORE, 34 BE IT PROPOSED BY THE ARKANSAS LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE NINETIETH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS: 35 36

1	THAT the Arkansas Legislative Council refer to the House Committee on
2	Judiciary a request to study the circumstances concerning and procedures for
3	fingerprinting and photographing a juvenile for law enforcement purposes, as
4	well as the requirements and process for sealing or expunging those records.
