17	Auditor of State, and the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State a miscellaneous
18	fund to be known as the "Department of County Operations Fund".
19	(b) The fund shall consist of:
20	(1) General revenues as may be provided by law;
21	(2) Nonrevenue income derived from services provided by the
22	various programs of the Department of County Operations;
23	(3) Any other nonfederal grants-in-aid funds provided by law;
24	(4) Funds received from the Department of Education for surplus
25	commodities; and
26	(5) Federal reimbursement received on account of eligible
27	expenditures of the Department of County Operations.
28	(c) Other federal reimbursement funds received by the Department of
29	<u>County Operations shall be deposited into a separate federal reimbursement</u>
30	fund on the books of the Treasurer of State.
31	(d) The fund shall be used for maintenance, operations, and
32	improvements required by the Department of County Operations in carrying out
33	its powers, functions, and duties.

35	SECTION 5. Arkansas Code § 20-77-1103 is amended to read as follows:
36	20-77-1103. Definitions.

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1 For purposes of this subchapter: 2 (1) "Family" means a family as defined in the Medical Services Policy Manual of published by the Division Department of County Operations of 3 4 the Department of Human Services; and 5 (2) "Healthcare coverage" means healthcare insurance as defined 6 by rules promulgated by the Department of Human Services for the ARKids First 7 Program. 8 9 SECTION 6. Arkansas Code § 25-10-102(a), concerning the organization 10 of the Department of Human Services, is amended to read as follows: 11 (a) The Department of Human Services shall consist of and be operated 12 under an integrated service system consisting of the following divisions with responsibilities and programs assigned to them as determined by the Director 13 14 of the Department of Human Services: 15 (1) A The Division of Aging and Adult Services; 16 (2) A The Division of Medical Services; 17 (3) A The Division of Behavioral Health Services, which shall 18 include community mental health centers and state hospitals; 19 (4) A The Division of Developmental Disabilities Services, which 20 shall include both community programs and human development centers; 21 (5) A Division of County Operations; 22 (6) A The Division of Administrative Services; 23 (7)(6) A The Division of Youth Services, which shall include 24 serious offender and community-based programs and the youth service centers; 25 (8)(7) A The Division of Community Service and Nonprofit 26 Support; 27 (9) (8) A The Division of State Services for the Blind; 28 (10)(9) A The Division of Children and Family Services; and 29 (11)(10) A The Division of Child Care and Early Childhood 30 Education. 31 32 SECTION 7. Arkansas Code § 25-10-132 is amended to read as follows: 33 25-10-132. Medical services and county operations - Use of local 34 funds. To the extent allowed by federal requirements, including waiver, 35 36 demonstration, and pilot project options, the Division of Medical Services of

14	powers, duties and functions, records, property, personnel, unexpended
15	balances of appropriations, allocations, or other funds are transferred by a
16	type 3 transfer to the Arkansas Energy Office of the Arkansas Economic
17	Development Commission.
18	(2) This transfer does not conflict with any duties,
19	responsibilities, or powers of the office.
20	(b) Unspent funds associated with the Weatherization Assistance
21	Program shall be transferred from the Department of Human Services to the

4	(b) The executive head of the department shall be the Director of the
5	Department of County Operations to be appointed by the Governor with consent
6	of the Senate to serve at the pleasure of the Governor.

8	25-43-103. Duties and responsibilities.
9	(a) The Department of County Operations shall:
10	(1) Determine the eligibility of individuals applying for
11	benefits in the Arkansas Medicaid Program, the Supplemental Nutrition
12	Assistance Program under 7 U.S.C. § 2011 et seq., and the Transitional
13	Employment Assistance Program under §§ 20-76-401 and 20-76-402;
14	(2) Redetermine the eligibility of individuals renewing benefits
15	in the Arkansas Medicaid Program, the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance
16	Program under 7 U.S.C. § 2011 et seq., and the Transitional Employment
17	Assistance Program under §§ 20-76-401 and 20-76-402; and
18	(3) Fulfill other duties and responsibilities previously held by
19	the Division of County Operations of the Department of Human Services,
20	including without limitation rulemaking, licensing, promulgation of rules,
21	rates, and standards, and the rendering of findings, orders, and
22	adjudications.
23	(b) The Director of the Department of County Operations shall report
24	quarterly to the Governor and the General Assembly regarding the results of
25	the eligibility determinations.
