1 INTERIM STUDY PROPOSAL 2015-156 2 REQUESTING THE ARKANSAS LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE NINETIETH 3 4 ARKANSAS GENERAL ASSEMBLY TO REFER TO THE SENATE AND HOUSE 5 COMMITTEES ON PUBLIC HEALTH, WELFARE, AND LABOR A STUDY OF THE 6 PRESENT STATUTORY FRAMEWORK REGARDING WASTE TIRES WITH THE GOAL 7 OF FINDING SOLUTIONS TO THE CONTINUING PROBLEMS THAT ESCAPE THE 8 EXISTING FRAMEWORK. 9 10 WHEREAS, Arkansas created in 1991 a statewide program to protect the 11 public health and safety and the state's environmental quality by setting and 12 implementing standards to be followed in the hauling, storage, recycling, and disposal of waste tires, yet problems with waste tires continue to affect 13 14 public health and safety and the environment in this state; and 15 16 WHEREAS, waste tire dumps can attract rodents and mosquitoes, create the danger of disease, and present serious fire hazards; and 17 18 19 WHEREAS, a fire recently erupted in an illegal waste tire dump in 20 Southeast Pulaski County; and 21 22 WHEREAS, according to the Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality 23 that fire caused chemicals in the tires to break down and leak into the 24 ground; and 25 26 WHEREAS, the department reported that any groundwater contamination 27 resulting from the fire would fall under Arkansas Department of Environmental 28 Quality solid waste regulations, but the site is not considered a hazardous waste dump; and 29 30 31 WHEREAS, the fire erupted despite the repeated attempts of the 32 Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality to contact the owners of the property to begin the process of remediation; and 33 34 35 WHEREAS, the fire and its consequences occurred despite the extensive 36 statutory framework presently in place in this state and despite the long
