8	using a personal electronic device during the school day.

12	device under subdivision (b)(2)(A) of this section shall be permitted only

34	accessibility;			
35	(5) Digital media player;			
36	(6) Portable game console;			

1	(7) Tablet, notebook, or laptop computer;			
2	(8) Digital camera; and			
3	(9) Digital video or audio recorder.			
4	(b) A school district may establish a written student discipline policy			
5	and exemptions concerning the possession and use by a student of a personal			
6	electronic device:			
7	(1) On school property;			
8	(2) At an after-school activity; or			
9	(3) At a school-related function.			
10	(c) The policy may, without limitation:			
11	(1) Allow or restrict the possession and use of a personal			
12	electronic device;			
13	(2) Allow the use of a personal electronic device in school for			
14	instructional purposes at the discretion of a teacher or administrator;			
15	(3) Limit the times or locations in which a personal electronic			
16	device may be used to make telephone calls, send text messages or emails, or			
17	engage in other forms of communication;			
18	(4) Allow or prohibit the use of any photographic, audio, or			
19	video recording capabilities of a personal electronic device while in school;			
20	(5) Exempt the possession or use of a personal electronic device			
21	by a student who is required to use such a device for health or another			
22	compelling reason;			
23	(6) Exempt the possession or use of a personal electronic device			
24	after normal school hours for extracurricular activities; and			
25	(7) Include other relevant provisions deemed appropriate and			
26	necessary by the school district.
