12	interim study proposal, initiated by the House Committee on Public Health,
13	Welfare, and Labor; and
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15	WHEREAS, healthcare legislation that falls under House Rule 72 is often
16	referred to as "scope of practice legislation"; and
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18	WHEREAS, decisions made by the General Assembly that authorize
19	healthcare providers to expand their scope of practice will directly impact
20	the quality of healthcare received by the citizens of Arkansas; and
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22	WHEREAS, an adverse impact of a decision made by the General Assembly
23	has the potential for serious health consequences for the citizens of
24	Arkansas; and
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26	WHEREAS, decisions made by the General Assembly regarding healthcare
27	scope of practice should be taken with the highest level of care and caution;

     practice legislation or scope of practice interim study proposal; and
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                 (3) Establishment of a Scope of Practice Advisory Committee.
