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1	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code Title 17, Chapter 81, Subchapter 3, is		
2	amended to add additional sections to read as follows:		
3	<u>17-81-318. Certified advanced practice chiropractic physician —</u>		
4	Licensure.		
5	(a) An individual shall be licensed by the Arkansas State Board of		
6	Chiropractic Examiners before the individual may practice as a certified		
7	advanced practice chiropractic physician.		
8	(b) The Arkansas State Board of Chiropractic Examiners may grant a		
9	license as a certified advanced practice chiropractic physician to an		
10	applicant who:		
11	(1) Submits an application on forms approved by the Arkansas		
12	State Board of Chiropractic Examiners;		
13	(2) Pays the appropriate fees as determined by the Arkansas		
14	State Board of Chiropractic Examiners; and		
15	(3) Provides the following documentation with their application		
16	stating that the applicant has successfully completed:		
17	(A) Either:		
18	(i) A competency examination administered by a		
19	nationally recognized credentialing agency; or		
20	(ii) A graduate degree in the chiropractic practice		
21	specialty after December 31, 2017; and		
22	(B) Ninety (90) hours of clinical and didactic education		
23	provided by an institution approved by both the Arkansas State Board of		
24	Chiropractic Examiners and the Arkansas State Medical Board.		
25	(c) The Arkansas State Board of Chiropractic Examiners may renew the		
26	license if the certified advanced practice chiropractic physician:		
27	(1) Submits the appropriate renewal forms and appropriate		
28	renewal fee as determined by the Arkansas State Board of Chiropractic		
29	Examiners;		
30	(2) Completes all continuing education required by the Arkansas		
31	State Board of Chiropractic Examiners;		
32	(3) Submits verification of good standing with the Arkansas		
33	Medical Board; and		
34	(4) Meets other requirements set by the Arkansas State Board of

35 <u>Chiropractic Examiners.</u>

1	(d) The Arkansas State Board of Chiropractic Examiners shall notify		
2	the applicant in writing within thirty (30) days of receipt of:		
3	(1) The initial application as to whether the application is		
4	complete or missing information; and		
5	(2) The completed application as to whether the application is		
6	approved or denied.		
7	(e) If the Arkansas State Board of Chiropractic Examiners denies the		
8	application, the notice of denial shall state the reason that the application		
9	was denied.		
10	(f) Between regular board meetings, the Executive Director of the		
11	Arkansas State Board of Chiropractic Examiners may grant a license to a		
12	chiropractic physician who meets all of the requirements in subsection (b) of		
13	this section.		
14	(g) The Arkansas State Board of Chiropractic Examiners may:		
15	(1) Refuse to grant a license;		
16	(2) Administer a public or private reprimand;		
17	(3) Revoke, suspend, limit, or otherwise restrict a license;		
18	(4) Require a certified advanced practice chiropractic physician		
19	to submit to the care, counseling, or treatment of a physician or physicians		
20	designated by the Arkansas State Board of Chiropractic Examiners;		
21	(5) Suspend enforcement of its findings and place the certified		
22	advanced practice chiropractic physician on probation with the right to		
23	vacate the probationary order for noncompliance; or		
24	(6) Restore or reissue, at its discretion, a license and impose		
25	any disciplinary or corrective measure that may have been imposed previously.		
26	(h) The Arkansas State Board of Chiropractic Examiners shall notify		
27	the Arkansas State Board of Pharmacy of all certified advanced practice		
28	chiropractic physician licenses by September 1 of each licensing period.		
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30	<u> 17-81-319. Prescriptive authority — Chiropractic formulary.</u>		
31	(a) A chiropractic physician who is not a certified advanced practice		
32	chiropractic physician may administer, dispense, and prescribe any natural		
33	substance that is to be used in an oral or a topical manner as long as the		
34	<u>substance is not a dangerous drug.</u>		

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1	(b) A certified advanced practice chiropractic physician may prescribe		
2	and administer through injection any substances listed in the chiropractic		
3	formulary.		
4	(c) The Arkansas State Board of Chiropractic Examiners shall:		
5	(1) Create a chiropractic formulary;		
6	(2) Review the chiropractic formulary for necessary amendments;		
7	and		
8	(3) Provide appropriate education or training for any additions		
9	to the chiropractic formulary.
