11	TO DESIGNATED BENEFICIARIES OR SURVIVORS OF POLICE
12	OFFICERS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

16	TO AMEND PROVISIONS PROVIDING DEATH
17	BENEFITS TO DESIGNATED BENEFICIARIES OR
18	SURVIVORS OF POLICE OFFICERS.
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21	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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23	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 12-8-212 is amended to read as follows:
24	12-8-212. Death benefits — Definitions.
25	(a)(l)(A) When any <u>a</u> police officer of the Department of Arkansas
26	State Police shall have lost his or her life in <u>dies in</u> the course of
27	employment, then upon satisfactory proof of that fact made to the Arkansas
28	State Police Commission, a death benefit in the sum of twenty-five thousand
29	dollars (\$25,000) fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) shall be paid to the
30	surviving spouse of the deceased police officer.
31	(B) In case no spouse survives If there is not a surviving
32	spouse of the police officer, the death benefit under subdivision (a)(1)(A)
33	of this section shall be distributed equally among the police officer's
34	children.

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1	(C) If there is not a surviving spouse or surviving
2	children of the police officer, the death benefit under subdivision (a)(l)(A)
3	of this section shall be paid into the estate of the police officer.
4	(2) The sum of twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) <u>death</u>
5	benefit under subdivision (a)(l)(A) of this section shall be paid from the
6	Department of Arkansas State Police Fund.
7	(b) As used in this section, "in the course of employment" means at
8	any time when an <u>a police</u> officer is on duty as a police officer or is
9	performing an act ordinarily performed by a police officer although the
10	police officer is not actually on duty at the time.
11	(c) Nothing contained in this section shall be construed to This
12	section does not limit or extinguish the right of any police officer or the
13	police officer's survivors to any other benefits provided by law.
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15	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 21-5-704(a), concerning the payment of
16	claims to covered public employees, their designated beneficiaries, or their
17	survivors, is amended to read as follows:
18	(a)(l)(A) The state shall pay to the designated beneficiary or, if
19	there is no designated beneficiary, then to the surviving spouse or surviving
20	children under the age of twenty-two (22) <u>years of age</u> or, if there is no
21	surviving spouse or surviving children under the age of twenty-two (22)
22	years of age, then to the surviving children twenty-two (22) years of age or
23	older or to the surviving parents of $\frac{1}{2}$ and $\frac{1}{2}$ covered public employee who is
24	killed in the official line of duty, the sum of fifty thousand dollars
25	(\$50,000).
26	(B) The state shall pay to the designated beneficiary or,
27	if there is no designated beneficiary, then to the surviving spouse or
28	surviving children under twenty-two (22) years of age or, if there is no
29	surviving spouse or surviving children under twenty-two (22) years of age,
30	then to the surviving children twenty-two (22) years of age or older or to
31	the surviving parents of a police officer who is killed in the official line
32	of duty the sum of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000)
33	(B)(C) In addition thereto, the municipality that employed
34	the police officer or firefighter shall, upon certification of the amount by
35	the police or fire department, pay to the designated beneficiary or, if there
36	is no designated beneficiary, then to the surviving spouse or surviving

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children under the age of twenty-two (22) years of age or, if there is no
surviving spouse or surviving children under the age of twenty-two (22) years
of age, then to the surviving children twenty-two (22) years of age or older
or to the surviving parents of the deceased police officer or firefighter an
allowance for all sick leave, vacation, or other leave time accumulated to
the credit of the police officer or firefighter at the time of his or her
death.

8 (2)(A) In the event If a covered public employee shall suffer 9 suffers an injury while engaged in the performance of official duties 10 resulting in his or her total and permanent disability, the disabled covered 11 public employee shall be entitled to the sum of ten thousand dollars 12 (\$10,000) from the State of Arkansas upon establishing proof of the total and 13 permanent disability.

(B) Proof of total and permanent disability shall be established by offering evidence that the covered public employee was unable to work in the employment position covered by this subchapter for a period of more than one (1) year or that the covered public employee received a disability rating in excess of twenty-five percent (25%) from the Workers' Compensation Commission.

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SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 21-5-705 is amended to read as follows:
 21-5-705. Payment of claim to designated beneficiaries or survivors of
 certain specified public employees killed in the line of duty - Funds.

(a)(1) The state shall pay the additional sum of one hundred fifty
thousand dollars (\$150,000) to the designated beneficiary, surviving spouse,
or surviving children under twenty-two (22) years of age of a:

27 (1)(A) Police officer, wildlife Wildlife enforcement officer, 28 commissioned law enforcement officer or emergency response employee of the 29 State Parks Division of the Department of Parks and Tourism, Department of 30 Community Correction employee, employee of the Department of Correction, 31 jailer, or coroner whose death occurred:

(A)(i) After January 1, 2003; and

33 (B)(ii) Either in the:

34 (i)(a) In the official Official line of duty as the
35 result of a criminal or negligent action of another person or persons or as
36 the result of the engagement in exceptionally hazardous duty; or

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1 (ii)(b) In the line Line of duty while the officer 2 or employee was performing emergency medical activities; 3 (2)(B) Firefighter, emergency medical technician, or employee of 4 the Arkansas Forestry Commission killed after July 1, 1987, while responding 5 to, engaging in, or returning from a fire, a rescue incident, a hazardous 6 material or bomb incident, an emergency medical activity, or simulated 7 training thereof; and 8 (3)(A)(i)(C)(i)(a) Firefighter killed in the line of duty after 9 January 1, 2012, including death from leukemia, lymphoma, mesothelioma, and 10 multiple myeloma and cancer of the brain, digestive tract, urinary tract, liver, skin, breast, cervix, thyroid, prostate, testicle, or a cancer that 11 12 has been found by research and statistics to show higher instances of 13 occurrence in firefighters than in the general population, if he or she was 14 exposed to a known carcinogen as determined by the Department of Health with 15 consideration to the findings of the International Agency for Research on 16 Cancer while in the official line of duty. 17 (ii)(b) Subdivision (a)(3)(A)(i)(a)(1)(C)(i)(a) of this section does not include a firefighter who was diagnosed with cancer 18 19 prior to the start of firefighter service. 20 (B)(ii) A death benefit under subdivision (a)(3)(A)(a)(1)(C)(i) of this section shall be is limited to: 21 22 (i)(a) A maximum of one hundred fifty thousand 23 dollars (\$150,000) per individual death, including educational benefits 24 provided in § 6-82-501 et seq.; and 25 (ii)(b) A firefighter who is under sixty-eight (68) 26 years of age. 27 (C)(i)(iii)(a) The Firefighter Benefit Review Panel is 28 created for the purpose of making recommendations to the Arkansas State 29 Claims Commission regarding determinations of death benefits under 30 subdivision (a)(3)(A)(a)(1)(C)(i) of this section for deaths associated with 31 cancer. 32 (ii)(b) The panel shall consist of the following seven (7) individuals to be appointed by the Governor: 33 34 (a) (1) One (1) licensed oncologist; 35 (b)(1)(2)(A) Two (2) firefighters paid by the 36 state, a county, or a municipality.

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1 (2)(B) One (1) firefighter under 2 subdivision (a)(3)(C)(ii)(b)(1)(a)(1)(C)(iii)(b)(2)(A) of this section shall 3 be appointed from a list of names submitted by the Arkansas Professional Fire 4 Fighters Association; (c)(1)(3)(A) Two (2) volunteer firefighters. 5 6 (2)(B) One (1) firefighter under 7 subdivision (a)(3)(C)(ii)(c)(1)(a)(1)(C)(iii)(b)(3)(A) of this section shall 8 be appointed from a list of names submitted by the Arkansas State 9 Firefighters Association; 10 (d)(4) One (1) fire chief who may be appointed 11 from a list of names submitted by the Arkansas Association of Fire Chiefs; 12 and 13 (e)(5) One (1) citizen with experience in 14 either cancer and healthcare professions or firefighter relations. 15 (iii)(a)(c)(l) Panel members shall serve a term of 16 four (4) years. 17 (b)(2) In the event of a vacancy in the 18 membership of the panel, the Governor shall appoint a person meeting the 19 applicable eligibility requirements of the vacated position to fill the 20 vacancy for the remainder of the unexpired term. 21 (iv)(a)(d)(1) The panel shall hold at least one (1) 22 regular meeting in each calendar year at a time and place determined by the 23 panel. 24 (b)(2) Special meetings may be called at the 25 discretion of the chair selected under subdivision 26 (a)(3)(C)(v)(a)(1)(C)(iii)(e) of this section. 27 (v)(e) The panel shall select a chair and vice chair 28 during the first annual meeting of each four-year term. 29 (vi)(f) Four (4) members of the panel shall 30 constitute a quorum to transact business. 31 (vii)(g) The members of the panel may receive 32 expense reimbursement in accordance with § 25-16-901 et seq. 33 (viii)(h) The panel shall: 34 (a)(1) Render advisory opinions and reports 35 concerning research and statistics that show higher instances of cancer among 36 firefighters;

1 (b)(2) Review claims for death benefits of 2 firefighters who have died of cancer; and 3 (c) (3) Make recommendations to the Arkansas 4 State Claims Commission on death benefit awards under subdivision 5 (a)(3)(A)(a)(1)(C)(i) of this section. 6 (D)(iv) This section: 7 (i)(a) Shall not be applied to any other benefits 8 granted by the state, a county, a city, or a municipality; and 9 (ii) (b) Does not grant a cause of action against the 10 state, a county, a city, or a municipality. (b) (2) In addition to the benefits provided for in subsection (a) 11 12 subdivision (a)(1) of this section, the state shall pay the additional sum of 13 twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) to the designated beneficiary, 14 surviving spouse, or surviving children under the age of twenty-two (22) 15 years of age of any police officer, a wildlife enforcement officer of the Arkansas State Game and Fish Commission, commissioned law enforcement officer 16 17 of the State Parks Division of the Department of Parks and Tourism, 18 Department of Community Correction employee, or employee of the Department of 19 Correction: 20 (1) (A) Who was wearing a bulletproof vest approved by the 21 Director of the Department of Arkansas State Police; and 22 (2)(B) Whose death occurred: 23 (A)(i) After July 1, 1989; and 24 (B)(ii) In the official line of duty as the result of a 25 criminal action of another person or persons. (b)(1) The state shall pay the additional sum of three hundred 26 27 thousand dollars (\$300,000) to the designated beneficiary, surviving spouse, or surviving children under twenty-two (22) years of age of a police officer 28 29 whose death occurred: 30 (A) After July 1, 2017; and 31 (B) Either in the: 32 (i) Official line of duty as the result of a 33 criminal or negligent action of another person or persons or as the result of 34 the engagement in exceptionally hazardous duty; or 35 (ii) Line of duty while the police officer was 36 performing emergency medical activities.

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1	(2) In addition to the benefits provided for in subdivision				
2	(b)(1) of this section, the state shall pay the additional sum of fifty				
3	thousand dollars (\$50,000) to the designated beneficiary, surviving spouse,				
4	or surviving children under twenty-two (22) years of age of a police officer:				
5	(A) Who was wearing a bulletproof vest approved by the				
6	Director of the Department of Arkansas State Police; and				
7	(B) Whose death occurred:				
8	(i) After July 1, 2017; and				
9	(ii) In the official line of duty as the result of a				
10	criminal action of another person or persons.				
11	(c)(l) Except as provided in subdivision (c)(2) of this section, the				
12	benefits shall be paid totally from state funds appropriated for these				
13	benefits. The funds shall not be reimbursed by a transfer or charging the				
14	funds against any state funds allocated for turnback to cities or counties or				
15	distributed to any other state department agency fund account other than the				
16	Arkansas State Claims Commission fund accounts and the Miscellaneous				
17	Revolving Fund Account.				
18	(2)(A) Seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000) of the one				
19	hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) provided in subdivision (c)(1) of				
20	this section shall be paid by the appropriate state department agency fund				
21	account.				
22	(B) The appropriate state department agency shall transfer				
23	the necessary funds to the Arkansas State Claims Commission fund accounts for				
24	payment.				
25	(d) The additional benefits provided in this section shall be paid to				
26	the designated beneficiary, surviving spouse, surviving children, or				
27	surviving parents in three (3) equal annual payments, the first of which				
28	shall be paid in July of the next fiscal year after the date of the original				
29	order of the Arkansas State Claims Commission establishing entitlement to				
30	additional payments and annually thereafter.				
31	(e) Determination of eligibility for the additional payments provided				
32	\underline{for} in this section shall be made by the Arkansas State Claims Commission in				
33	accordance with Arkansas State Claims Commission rules and procedures.
